celebrate the WWD-2022. The children, who attend classes in temp. Tents made by HAI, participated with great interest in the following amazing activities -

1. Three students (5th to 8th graders) wrote essays on saving water in Hindi. They started to learn Hindi from the teachers provided by HAI only a few months ago. The recitations in Hindi by the students amazed us. HAI CEO, Sudhanshu Singh is an expert in Hindi and ensured that the children learn it well. A few pics of recitation below.

4. Water Quality testing .

The groundwater filtration system installed at the camp site by ROW-team in coordination with HAI was providing safe drinking water for the community. However, a few days before our visit one of the PVC pipe was damaged by Cattles grazing near the area. The whole system is being fixed and arrangements are being made to keep that secured from animals. See pictures below.

Delhi water supply was providing water to the community by using their truck, which was tested and the quality was found adequately safe (TDS - 120 ppm) for drinking.

5. Tree planting - 25 trees (Neem, Jamun, Peepal, and others) by puja, Heena and participants from the community planted the baby trees. The trees were named after the participants who planted and they are responsible for watering and looking after their own tree. See pictures below.
