The teachers and students from the Thansing Rashtriya Secondary School, Nuwakot District, Nepal conducted the World Water Day 2018 activities on March 24th, 2018.

The ROW team from Nepal led by ROW Coordinators - Bishnu Prasad Adhikary, Founder President, Agaman Academy in Thansing, Nuwakot, and Rameshwor Adhikari, principal of the Kakani Lower Secondary School successfully conducted awareness events in Thansing, Nuwakot District on March 24th.

The Thansing Secondary School conducted several activities with the students for them to understand and protect the water quality of the springs and streams by keeping trash only in containers and not throwing them out in open grounds or gullies. They also had a dance program to highlight the importance of protecting the streams and rivers.

The connectivity to the Thansing area by phone or internet is very challenging. We (ROW Foundation, Maryland, USA) received some of the information through our volunteer, Pranuj Mallya from Kathmandu, Nepal. The ROW coordinator, Bishnu Adhikari, sent a few pictures below covering only a part of the activities.

The summary information about the activities are provided below.

- About 90 students, teachers, and local people participated in the activities.
- The students and teachers did an awareness discussion.
- A cultural program with dance focusing on “nature for water and save our streams and rivers” was organized.

- There were a number of teachers who participated in the events and encouraged the students.
- The teachers urged the students and local people to protect their streams and rivers by using the trash bins to throw wastes, and separate bins to throw papers and plastics for recycling. They can also use locally made pits to throw vegetable and other yard wastes, which can be composted and used as fertilizers.

ROW Foundation Coordinator, Mr. Bishnua Prasad Adhikari verbally relayed the information on the events and sent the following few pictures.
