As a part of the Rivers of the World program, the Himalayan English School (HES) students, teachers and the local communities here in Ghansali conducted the WWD 2019 on 22nd March 2019

Approximately 1000 students from nearby three schools and one college participated in the event. The name of schools and colleges are –

- 1. Saraswati Vidya Mandir Inter College GHANSALI 415 Students
- 2. Government Inter College Ghumetidhar GHANSALI 194 Students
- 3. Government Girls Inter College Baheda GHANSALI 58 Students
- 4. Saraswati sishu Mandir GHANSALI 301 Students

In addition to above, about 200 students from Himalayan English School also participated in the event.

Mr. Debesh Krishan Das, Chemistry teacher in Himalayan English School explained the importance of water and the water quality testing methods to all the students. He explained how HES students participated in Seminars in Rishikesh and presented this work in front of many other school students.

Mr. Sudhir K Nautiyal explained various reasons of growing water scarcity in the society and the remedial action which are to be taken by us. A power point presentation was shown to the participants about the subject 'Why Waste Water?'.

HES Students shared their experience of water sample collection, testing procedure and summarizing of results. The power point presentation was shown how waster testing work started in Himalayan English School. They also explained the future program of testing drinking water - like conducting more water testing in this area and organizing seminars to spread this awareness among the students of other schools.

The program lasted about 2 hours in which students from other schools took great interest and participated in the question answer session.



A poster making competition, art competition and Essay writing competition were organized among students in groups A to D consists the I to X class students.


Different topics related to water conservation were given to respective groups.
