Bhubaneswar, Odisha Rally to Conserve Water for Future Generation

On March 22, 2018 the SOA University, Institute of Business and Computer Studies (IBCS) conducted the WWD 2018. The Rivers of the World (ROW) team lead by the coordinator, Anup Samantaray, Dean IBCS organized the rally to raise awareness towards protection and conservation of waters of streams, Rivers (Daya, Mahanadi) and other water bodies in the area.
