
Aren't We Lucky?!

Any water that is Subsurface Water where all the interstices of the soil are completely saturated with water (Saturated Zone)

CHALLENGES

- WITHDRAWLS (600 km³/year in 1900 to 1,300 km³/year in 2017)
 - AGRICULTURE
 - INDUSTRY
 - MINING
 - CLIMATE CHANGE

Bangladesh, China, India, Indonesia, Pakistan, Iran, and Turkey Account for ~ 60% of Groundwater Withdrawl
