The Summary of this year's activities below -

- A total of 18 volunteers participated in the programme.
- The event was organised on Sunday, April 3rd '2022.
- The volunteers cleaned the bank of the Brahmaputra River, collected trash and disposed them to the nearby Municipal trash collection point.
- The team collected about 500 Kgs of waste from the site.
- The volunteers communicated with the local people and urged them to keep the river bank clean by placing all plastics and other trash in trash bins.
- The invading weeds covering the clear area were removed as it harbors the throw away items by the visitors and convert the area into a dumping site. They explained that to the local people. This will make the river bank more useful and better.
- The Brahmaputra River team coordinator and other members of the ROW Foundation plan to have a follow up visit there and pursue this effort.
